



Worship Team Expectations

- The worship team member must attend all regularly scheduled practices. If you cannot be at rehearsal, please let the Worship Pastor or church office know **AHEAD** of rehearsal time. The only absences that are excused are: Sickness, death in family, work (during rehearsal), vacation, away for church business.
- A pattern of excessive absences will result in the worship team member being removed from the music ministry until a return is approved by the Worship Pastor. Short-term sabbaticals are allowed in legitimate circumstances, but will not be allowed on a repeated basis.
- The worship team member will make a constant effort to better his or her vocal or playing abilities by heeding to the advice and instruction of the Worship Pastor.
- The worship team member will constantly remember that as a team member, they are assisting the worship leader in leading the people in worship. Be an example! Remember that you bring joy, faith, excitement about the Lord, your personal testimony, encouragement, and so much more to the "table" in ministering with the worship team!
- As a courtesy to other members of the ministry team, each member should be in their seat at the appropriate rehearsal time. Excessive tardiness shows lack of discipline, and this is not in line with the level of excellence that the Lord requires. If there is a situation where a team member will be late (due to work or otherwise), they should notify the church office of this situation so the Worship Pastor is aware of why they are late.
- The worship team member is to make every effort to be at any extra practices, as well as all other services or programs. Missing any of these events must be approved by the Worship Pastor **AHEAD** of time.
- The worship team member will make every effort to be hospitable and friendly to fellow team members, including first-time visitors. Enlarge your circle of love!

- The worship team member must be committed to unity with the ministry team! Unity is essential for effective ministry, but it doesn't happen accidentally. It takes work and effort to be unified! God commands us to be united!
- For the worship team members that are on a rotation, they are expected to be at and in service on the days they are not ministering.
